The Mission of the Egan Warming Center is to ensure that homeless people in Lane County have a warm and safe place to sleep when temperatures drop below 30 degrees between November 15th and March 31st.

Last winter over 300 volunteers at six sites activated for 21 nights, providing over 4500 beds and 9000 meals.
