The Warming Center mission is simple: to ensure that homeless people in Lane County have a place to sleep indoors when temperatures drop to 30 degrees Fahrenheit or below between November 15th and March 31st. Last year our sites were open for 21 nights during this period. We have 6 facilities around the greater Eugene-Springfield area where we can let people sleep on a cold night. We served over 200 people on an average night.
